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- This is a comprehensive Art Program with a duration of 12 weeks in 2 hour sessions.
- Every student (we call them creators) and a family member or best friend (aka co-creators) go
 through the entire learning process together, each one produces a design portfolio and an art
 exhibition upon graduation.
- Disciplines involved: Art History, Photography, Mixed Media, Carving, Print Making, Painting, Design Thinking, Mindfulness, among others.
- Activities: Hands-on Art workshops, Museum visit, activities with parents, etc.
- This is a dynamical Art program that provides core knowledge of Art history, visual communications, World cultures and profound graphic language understanding.
- Each student will learn the use of tools, theory, mediums and materials related to current visual communication languages.
- We aim to facilitate the habit of self-empowerment and help them cope with stress, anxiety and fears through the use of diverse non-dogmatic wellness tools such as mindfulness.
- The program contains business development components and we help them place their artworks in diverse points of sale around the region.
